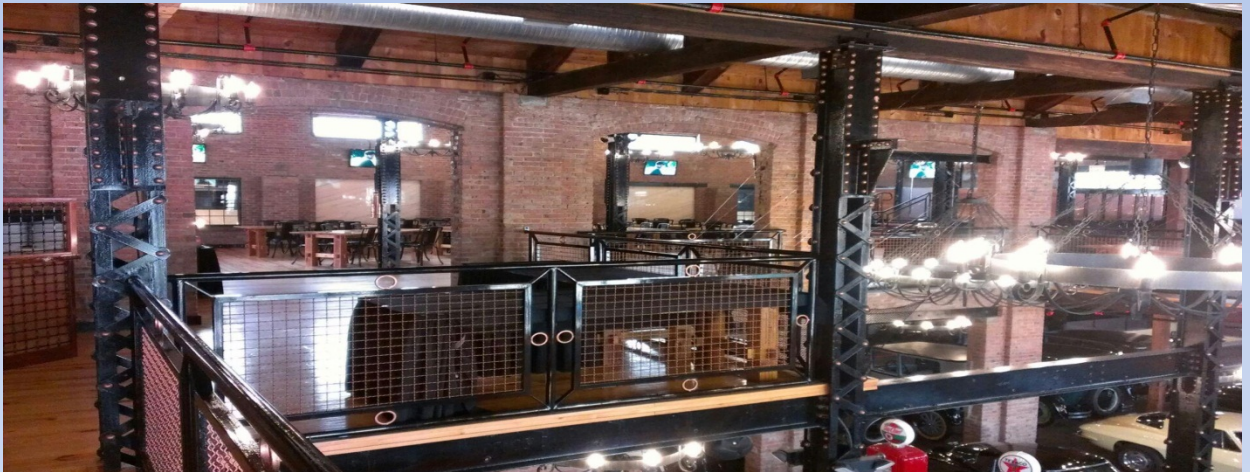

DIRECTIONS

From South Jersey - Take NJ Turnpike to Exit 13 A toward Newark Airport. Merge onto NJ 81 North and take exit on the left toward US 1-9/Newark. Keep to the left and follow signs for NJ 21. Take NJ 21 for 1.2 miles and turn right onto Miller Street. Take the 2nd right onto Avenue A.

From North Jersey – Take NJ Turnpike to exit 14-14C, Interstate 78 toward US 1&9. Follow signs for I-78 West. Take I-78 West and follow signs for US 1&9, US 21/21 Newark (on the left). Take NJ 21 North. Turn right onto Miller Street and take 2nd right onto Avenue A.
